Contract Term & Conditions

Article 1 (Definition of terms)

1. "Exhibitors" shall be companies, associations, individuals and organizations, which submit entry application for the exhibition.
2. "Exhibition" shall be Global Electric Power Tech
3. "Organizer" shall be Korea Electric Engineers Association and kotra

Article 2 (Participation and contract)

1. Those who want to participate the event shall write a contract form and submit it to the organizer.

Article 3 (Allocation of area to exhibit)

1. The organizer assigns space in order of application and payment.
2. If necessary, in consideration of effects, efficiency and harmony of the exhibition, the organizer can change the location which is assigned to exhibitors. This is discretion of the organizer and exhibitors cannot ask compensation for the results of the change.

Article 4 (Exhibition booth management)

1. Exhibitors shall display exhibits shown on their application and allow their staffs to manage their booth.
2. In case exhibitors display different exhibits from their original display lists or sell them without a permission of the organizer, the organizer can order withdrawal, take-out and cancellation immediately. In that case, the entry fee is not given back and exhibitors cannot demand compensation for this.
3. If necessary, the organizer can stop certain people from entering the exhibition.
4. The exhibitor cannot transfer all or some of the allocated areas without a written consent of organizer.
5. Exhibitors are not allowed to alter the exhibition's original state like painting of floor, ceiling, pillars or walls of the exhibition and shall compensate the organizer for loss through proper management.

Article 5 (Payment conditions)

1. Exhibitors shall pay 50% of the contract fee within 7 days after sending application and then pay the remainder until March 20, 2010.
2. If exhibitors do not pay the remainder within the period, the organizer can cancel the participation contract and in that case, the paid fee shall not be returned.

Article 6 (Cancellation)

1. If exhibitors deny the use of the allotted booth or do not pay the participation fee within the period, the organizer can unilaterally cancel the contract and in that case, the paid fee shall not be returned.
2. If exhibitors want to cancel the contract, they have to notify the cancellation in writing to the organizer 60 days before the exhibition and in that case, the paid fee is not returned.

3. Exhibitors shall not cancel the contract and if exhibitors inevitably give up their participation, exhibitors must pay 100% participation fee in two weeks as cancel charge.

Article 7 (Cancellation or change of exhibition)

1. If the exhibition is cancelled by the organizer, 100% of the paid fee should be returned to exhibitors. But if force majeure or specific condition causes the cancellation, changes the opening day or reduces the show period, then the fee shall not be given back. And in that case, exhibitors cannot demand compensation.

Article 8 (Construction and display of exhibits)

1. Exhibitors should complete the display of equipment and exhibits at their assigned area. If needed an extra time, exhibitors should get the approval from the organizer and pay for it. All the exhibit companies should be registered at the COEX(Ltd).

Article 9 (Move-out of exhibits and equipment)

1. Exhibitors shall take out all the equipment and exhibits during the exhibition period and in case it is delayed, they should immediately pay all the costs which organizer could bear.

Article 10 (Security)

1. The organizer shall take some protection measures for the exhibition and visitors.
2. The exhibitor shall be completely responsible for damage and theft of exhibits and devices during the exhibition and withdrawal.

Article 11 (Fire regulation)

1. All the materials including decorative material in the exhibition shall be non-flammable according to the Fire Services Act.
2. The exhibitor shall be completely responsible for the damage and theft of exhibits and devices during the exhibition and withdrawal.

Article 12 (Supplementary regulation)

1. The organizer, if necessary, could establish a supplementary regulation that is not originally described on the participation conditions.
2. The supplementary regulation shall become a part of the participation conditions and exhibitors should follow it.

Article 13 (Dispute settlement)

1. For the possible dispute as to interpretation of the participation conditions between the organizer and exhibitors or rights and duties of them, they should accept the judgment of Korean Commercial Arbitration Board and shall not bring a lawsuit against the decision.
